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

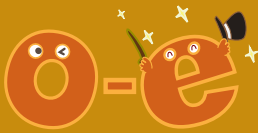

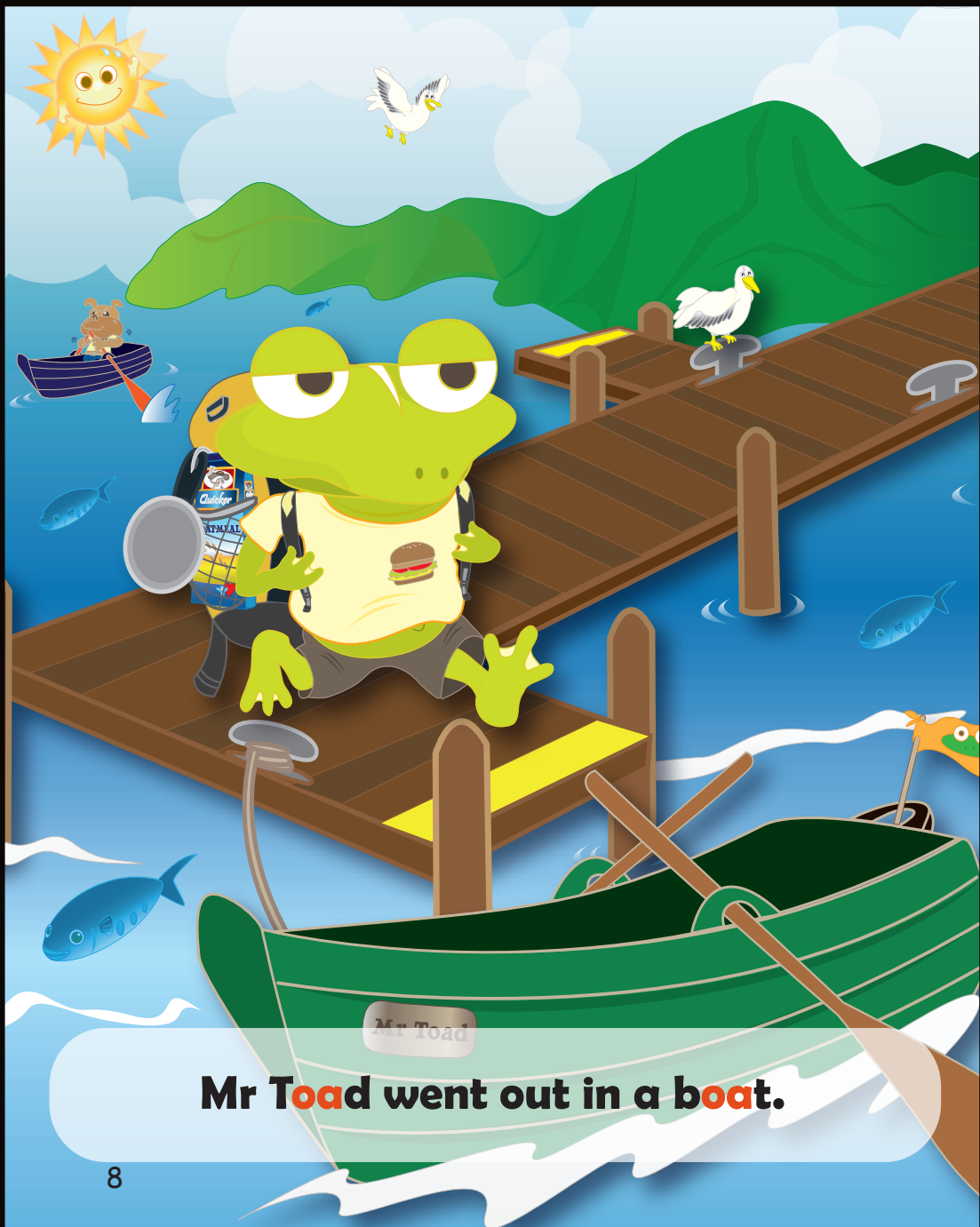

He drops the **hoe** on his **toe**.

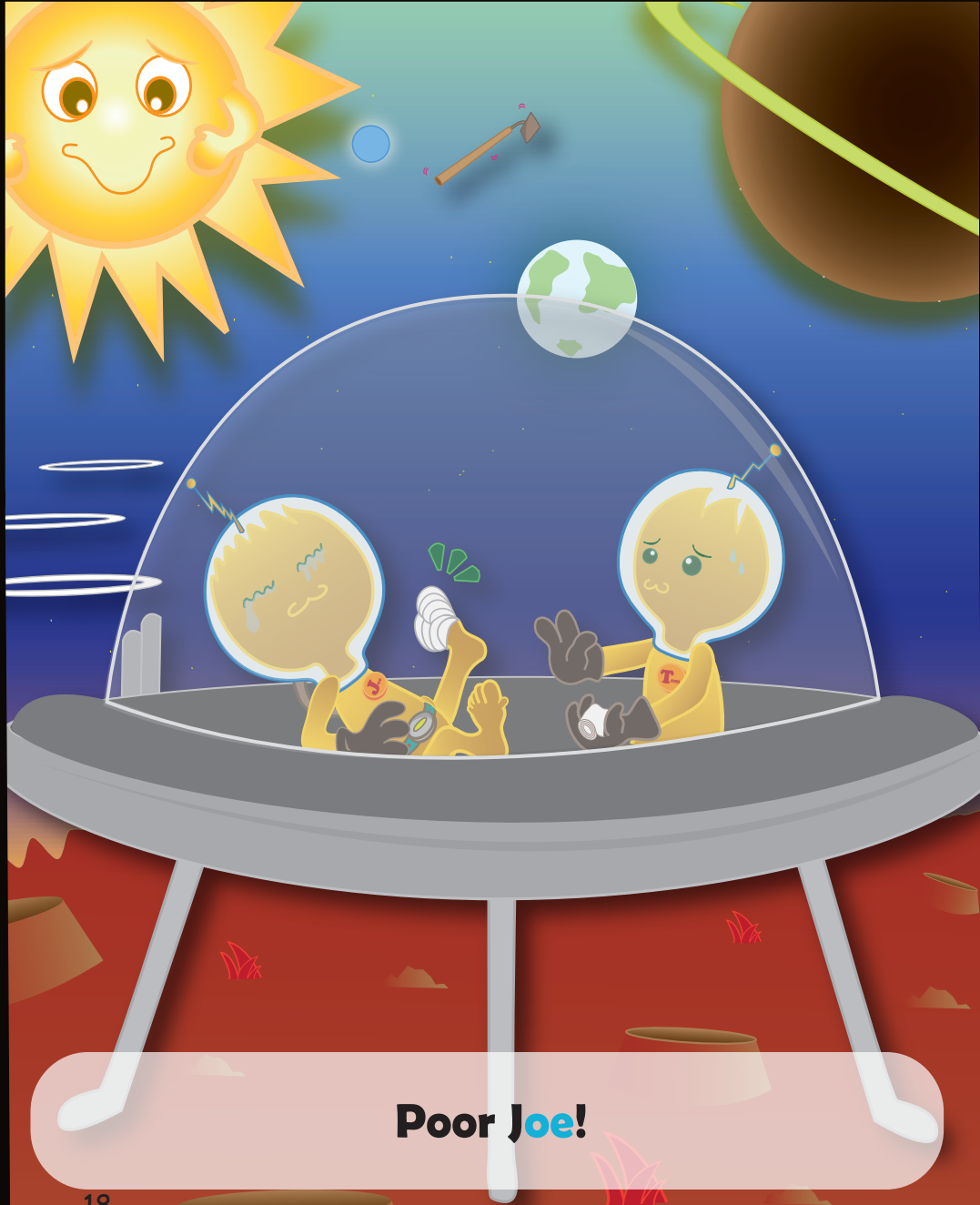

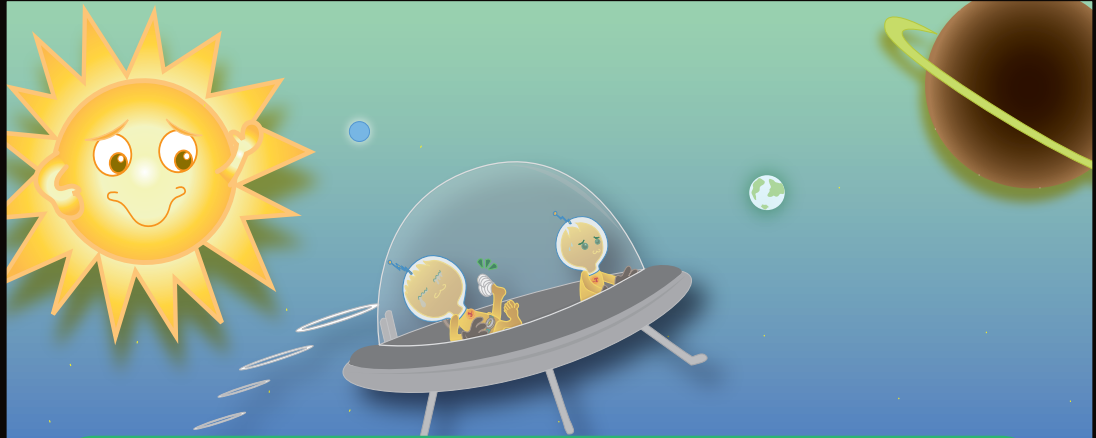

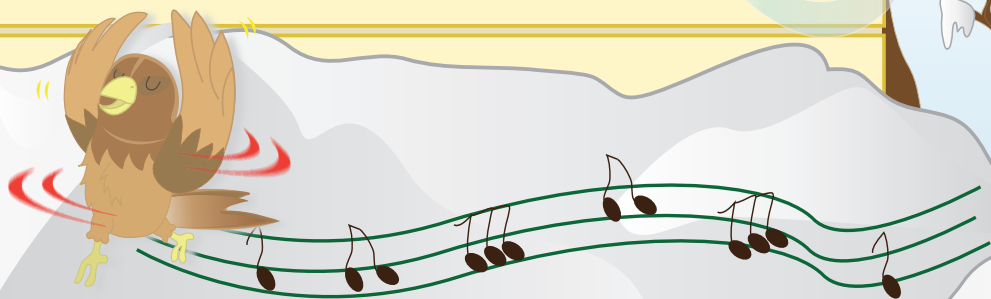

This old dog then ate the **bone**!

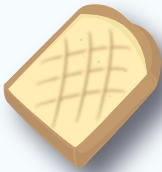


# A Toad in a Boat

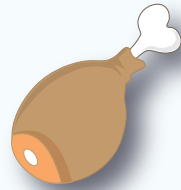


Green **toad** in a **boat**,

# Woe is Joe

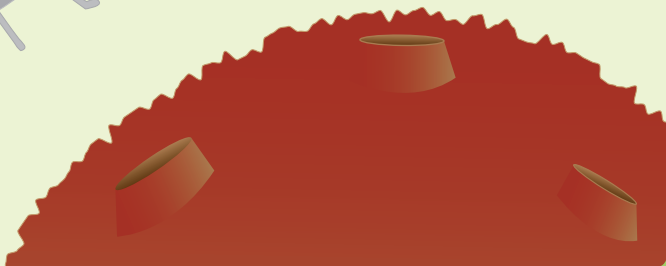
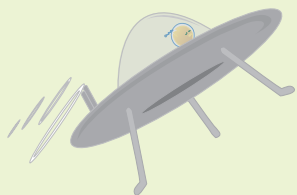
Poor **Joe**, poor **Joe**,
